



Oldershaw School 16-19 Catch Up Statement

The Oldershaw School will be providing extra tuition sessions for eligible students. The guidance indicates that students with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) and/or those who have an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP) will also be eligible for support via this Fund. Although the funding has been allocated to support students who have not achieved a grade 5 in English and/or Mathematics by the age of 16, the support does not have to be used solely for English and Mathematics tuition.

The funds will be used in the following way

- Small group tuition and or online, which is in addition to their timetabled subject sessions. These sessions will be conducted by our qualified staff. The small group tuition objective is to maximise exam achievement and ensure that students are ready to progress to exam questions.
- Additional sessions may be run after school, or half-term & end of term holidays
- Bespoke support to mitigate the impact of COVID-19, this includes, but is not limited to, personal development skills, positive mental health strategies and exam preparation.
- Ensure students have access to the wealth of resources and support available online.
