

Draft Behaviour Policy Addendum – Covid 19 (subject to governor approval)

Enhanced Hygiene

All pupils:

- must wash their hands using the new sinks on the yard on arrival at school
- are encouraged to bring hand sanitiser to use sensibly
- are encouraged to wash their hands at break, after using the toilet and before & after eating
- must wear full uniform which should be washed as usual
- must use a tissue (available in every classroom) to catch coughs and sneezes
- must place tissues – and all other litter - in a bin

Illness

If pupils have one of the following symptoms in school, they must tell an adult straight away:

- a high temperature – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- a new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

Expectations of Behaviours

In addition to the usual school rules, all pupils should:

- follow the one-way system at all times
- move to lessons quickly and sensibly – without waiting for friends
- remain within their own year groups whenever possible
- follow the enhanced hygiene rules
- only use their own pencil case and equipment
- be respectful of other people's feelings and personal space about Covid19
- be respectful of our neighbours and people in the community when travelling to and from school

Any pupil not meeting these expectations will be dealt with proportionately on an individual basis in line with the behaviour policy.
